

SWEET SIXTEEN RACING FORMAT

1. All cars will draw for qualifying order at the time they pay their entry fee. They must qualify within two spots of that order or be penalized.
2. Qualifications will be two laps back to back.
3. Top sixteen (16) qualifiers are locked into the feature event.
4. Top six (6) of the sixteen (16) qualifiers will draw for starting positions, in qualifying order, for a six lap dash. Remaining ten (10) qualifiers will draw for starting spots, in qualifying order, for a ten lap heat race. The remaining qualifiers seventeen (17) through the total car count will run a last chance race with six (6) cars transferring to the main event. If more than thirty five (35) cars, there will be two (2) last chance races with the top three (3) out of each transferring to the main event.
5. After the above races are run, fast time will draw an 8, 10, or 12. This is the number of cars that will re-draw for a starting spot for the feature, six (6) from the dash plus the top two (2) finishers from the heat, if an eight was drawn. Or top four finishers (4) if the ten was drawn. Or top six (6) finishers if the twelve was drawn. (NOTE: *You want to be fast in qualifying to get in the top six and have a chance at drawing the pole for the race. Also the top six always draw in qualifying order, so if you are fast time, you are the first to draw so the one is still in the bag to draw. If you are in the heat you want to finish as good as you can, because the re-draw is 8, 10, or 12, the top two finishers are in the re-draw and could draw the pole. If you can not make the top two then maybe the re-draw number is 12, meaning the top six out of the heat will re-draw and you could still draw the pole.*)
6. The finish of the heat, lines up as it finished behind the re-draw. The last chance lines up behind the heat.
7. The final two spots are left to the top two in points not already in the feature and have competed in the last chance race(s).
8. If the starting grid is for more than twenty four (24) spots the format remains the same, you take more cars out of the last chance race(s).
